Introduction

- Most of us believe that we are from the planet Earth; and why not? We are surely not from Mars or Venus....

- we and billions of other people live in hundreds of different countries.
 - We order our lives according to the governments and cultures of those countries
 - We live, and raise our families here
 - It's all our parents, grandparents and great grandparents ever knew.
 - We limit our whole lives to what's on earth, because that's the way everybody has been living

- * But what if there is more? * what if when we belong to the King - Jesus Christ, we also belong to a country that supersedes any of the countries on earth we know?

- We think of the kingdom of God as some future destination
 - Some invisible reality when we die
 - The truth is & for some difficult to understand
 - Truth is that the kingdom of God is here and now!
 - And I want to be clear, the kingdom of God is here now in a spiritual sphere.
 - It can not be seen as yet, Jesus Christ will come to put up this visible physical kingdom
 - But this Kingdom's influence can be seen and experienced!!

Difference between heaven & earth

Matthew 6: 9-10

Kingdom Now

Matthew 6:10

- We started looking at this scripture that is about the Kingdom of God coming on earth as in Heaven
- What does this mean? What is God's Kingdom?
- Let's take a closer look at this word "Kingdom"

the Greek word is "Basileia"

in the Strong (Concordance G932) it means the following:

Royal power: Of the royal power of Jesus as triumphant Messiah

- ↳ the right or authority to rule over a Kingdom
- ↳ royal power conferred on Christians in Christ's kingdom

Kingship: To be King over, to be in the position of a King

- ↳ To rule over

Dominion: Sovereignty or Control — Lordship

- ↳ The territory of a government

Rule: Control over an area or people

- ↳ A code of practice and discipline for a religious order or community

* "Basileia" comes from the root word "Basileus" (Strong G935) which relates to the idea of a "foundation of Power"

* The Kingdom of God - is His realm and His foundation of Power on earth!!

* It is His dominion or lordship, in which He establishes His will here and now through the redeeming work of Jesus Christ in the lives of His people !!

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Qualities of the Kingdom of God:



① It is a Kingdom of Power, not just words

- The Kingdom of God was never meant to be proclaimed with words alone.
- Neither was it to be communicated as something that will come only in the future
- Always meant to be announced with power and in the present—in the Now!!

1 Thessalonians 1:5

↳ The Apostle Paul wrote

↳ Many speak about the Kingdom, but have no accompanying demonstration of what they teach.

↳ Words alone is not enough, there has to be an accompanying power - a visible demonstration of God's power to heal the sick, deliver the captives and the oppressed, and save the lost.

Matthew 4:23

↳ this is the gospel Jesus Christ preached, and it was accompanied by power.

↳ The foundation of God's power (the Kingdom) manifested through Him and the gospel message He preached.

↳ Even Paul & the other apostles preached the gospel that was accompanied by power!!

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Qualities of the Kingdom of God:

② It is a Supernatural Kingdom.

John 18:36

- the Kingdom is not yet physical, nor does it have an earthly capital yet.
- It is a supernatural, or spiritual Kingdom. Its capital is in Heaven, from which God reigns.
- The Greek word for the word that Jesus uses here for world is the word; - "Kosmos"

"Kosmos" means - constitution; order; government

- The Kingdom is not subject to this world order - or a part of it. It's a government on its own - and its supernatural meaning it is not natural; supernatural - some force beyond scientific understanding or the laws of nature
- The Kingdom of God is a force beyond scientific understanding
- The Kingdom of God is a force beyond the laws of nature.

Let's look at the story where Jesus raised Lazarus

John 11:38 - 44

- material universe
- number of nature - natural

- * Jesus walks in the foundation of God's Power, and the supernatural manifestation thereof.
- * The Kingdom of God is not of this world, its of the government of Heaven!!

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Qualities of the Kingdom of God:

③ It is an (Unshakable) Kingdom

- Not only will it not be shaken, it cannot be shaken - this is ultimate truth.
 - In this world everything is constantly changing. You will agree that things changed a lot just in the last months.
 - But God's Kingdom, is unchangeable & unshakable
 - Everything outside of God's Kingdom is shakable
 - There is shakings going on and there will be one great final shaking (Rev 6:12-17)
 - Jesus called these shakings - birth-pangs in (Matthew 24)
- * But we have received, and maybe you are only receiving it now - an unshakable Kingdom
- * As a child of God, that is obedient, even if the storm comes we will not be moved

Hebrews 12:28

unmoved;
firm; stable
immovable
unchangeable

Matthew 7:24-25

Romans 8:38-39

- Nothing can move us!!
- Even through the shaking, if we are in the unshakable Kingdom of God we cannot be moved
- In the Kingdom of God we are immovable!!

• State of him who is
as he ought to be
• the condition
acceptable to God

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Characteristics of the Kingdom of God:

Integrity, Virtue, purity of life, correctness of thinking & feeling & acting

① Righteousness

So living in righteousness means several things:

(right)

a.) Being in good standing with God by the forgiveness and redemption we receive through Christ's death and resurrection.

2 Corinthians 5:21

The kingdom of God doesn't consist in material things but in three main characteristics
*righteousness; peace; joy

b.) Acting in the same ways that God acts, as it says in

Micah 6:8

c.) Submitting yourself to be accountable to God for your thoughts, words, and actions, and allowing Him to correct us and to guide us.

Psalm 23:3 "Paths of righteousness
for His Name sake"

* To be within the Kingdom of God, we must be righteous, regardless of the church we belong to.

* We have to submit to the government of God, if we don't we are rebellious & unrighteous

→ (with a relationship with Jesus)

* Only those within the Kingdom can know righteousness, outside its satan rules.

* Good News is that everyone who repents can receive the righteousness that comes through faith in Jesus Christ → entry to Kingdom → Eternal life

Romans 14:17

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Characteristics of the Kingdom of God:

Romans 14:17

② Peace

- Righteousness and Peace comes together, the words righteousness and peace will always be related.
- We cannot experience true peace without having righteousness.
- Jesus wants to reign over the human race to bring it both righteousness and peace
- Rebellious people do not enjoy peace; you can even be religious and miss the peace of God!

Isaiah 9:6-7

Isaiah 32:17

God!

So what does this word "peace" really mean?

- The Hebrew word for peace is "Shalom" meaning
 - ↳ Completeness
 - ↳ Soundness
 - ↳ Safe; well
 - ↳ happy; health & prosperity

* Peace is one of the Kingdom benefits that comes as a result of being justified and made righteous by Jesus Christ

* This supernatural peace only comes through knowing Jesus Christ

- * And it will guard (shield) our hearts and minds

Philippians 4:7

Protect against damage or harm

* This peace that comes from the presence of the Lord brings us to a position of complete protection!!

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Characteristics of the Kingdom of God:

Romans 14:17

③ Joy

- The Kingdom of God also brings us joy!! As one of the characteristics of the Kingdom, we when we actively live in the Kingdom will experience this joy.
- There is a difference between happiness and joy.
- Happiness belongs to the realm of the soul, while joy belongs to the realm of the spirit

Happiness:

- It's connected to external circumstances
- Depending on the nature of those circumstances, we feel happy or sad
- So although a new car, a new house or a high paying job can bring you happiness..... it can never bring you true joy.
- All of these things (external) often changes, which means that happiness is temporal, at least that the world brings

Joy:

⇒ Nehemiah 8:10

- But joy, true joy is always related to a stable source that never changes, does not vary, and is not affected by external forces.
- Joy happens in our spirit, and when connected to King Jesus it remains constant. His Joy is our strength!!
- Regardless of the circumstances we might be experiencing.
- The joy of the Kingdom of God is constant, unchangeable through the Spirit of the Kingdom - The Holy Spirit.

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Conclusion

- In this series we have come to know that God's kingdom is present here on earth - Now!
- The "Basileia" = Royal Power; Kingship; Dominion; Rule of God is here on earth - Now!
